ARTISANS NEW CONSIGNORS PROGRAM

Artisans on fifth has been a not-for-profit owner's only, artists co-op since it's inception in 2009. As of February 1st, we will be welcoming a new Consignors program.

You will have many more types of art, from a wide variety of Florida artists and craftspeople to select from.

Artisans on fifth invites Florida artists and craftspeople to apply to be a Consignor. After being juried-in, an artist would submit several pieces of artwork to be displayed on a consignment basis. The Consignors are not required to work in the shop, and they receive 60% of each sale. There is a \$120 (\$20/month) fee for a 6-month contract.

why they are "united by a thread." The opening reception will coincide with Mount Dora's Second Friday Art Splash, scheduled for Friday, **February 10th**, **from 6-8pm**. The event is free and open to the public, and refreshments will be served. Exhibit will continue through February 28th during normal business hours.

Joyce Brady, a resident of Mount Dora, is a nationally acclaimed and award winning jewelry artist. Each piece Brady creates is an original work of art influenced by Native American, Egyptian and Victorian bead weaving and embroidery Her keen sense of color and design is evident in each piece she creates and allows the viewer and wearer to go on a journey of discovery: each bead, stone, art glass, silk etc adds to the adventure.





Heather Hopcraft, a resident of Umatilla, is a nationally-recognized fiber artist known for her use of color and

precision quilting. Her recent work includes original art quilts such as "The Zipper Club" and "Scissorfall"(currently featured in "Shared Threads" MDCA Gallery), and 3D fabric pyramids such as "Primary Metamorphosis" as well as knitted baby items at Artisans on fifth. "The Zipper Club" demonstrates Heather's joyful and positive outlook on life as she copes with health issues such as heart bypass surgery. Her 3D fabric pyramids, "Primary Metamorphosis" is sculptural piece that expands the concept of what can be created with fabric & thread.

In a recent "Lake and Sumter Style.com" magazine, it was reported that "Mount Dora has been ranked


