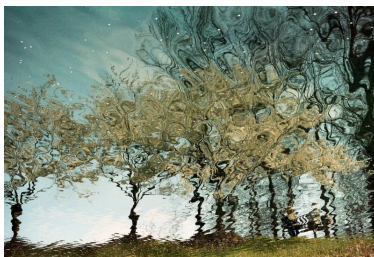

Artisans on fifth is dedicated to giving back to the community through an Annual Student Art Exhibit, Marilyn Dodge Scholarship (given yearly to a high school visual art student) and Bra-Vo (an art bra fundraiser). The co-operative features the work of over 25 local artists representing a broad range of mediums, from sculpture to painting to jewelry. The venture started with a dedicated small group of local artists, and with the help of the Mount Dora Center for the Arts, was launched as a venue for local, emerging artists to display their work in a professional gallery setting. The artists also staff the shop, and frequently offer demonstrations of their work while performing their routine staff duties.

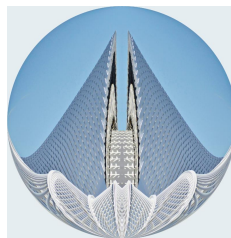

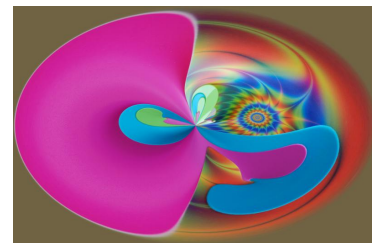
Laura is awarded 3 yellow ribbons in the 1st Triannual Photo Competition with the Florida Camera Council.

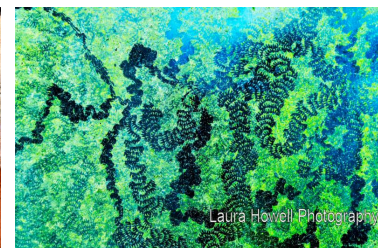

LEE AND MARILYN DODGE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR ART STUDENTS

Artisans recently lost our longtime benefactor, Lee Dodge after a valiant fight. Lee and his wife Marilyn were active supporters of the arts in Lake

County since their arrival in Mt. Dora.

Marilyn was one of the original members of Artisans on fifth and was an incredible jewelry artist that approached everyone with a beautiful smile. When Marilyn passed away, the family and Artisans started a yearly scholarship for a high school student in the visual arts. Artisans on fifth pays tribute to Marilyn's memory by making a donation annually to the Marilyn Dodge Scholarship Fund. The scholarship is distributed by the Women's Committee of Fine Arts of Mount Dora.

The Women's Committee of Fine Arts of Mount Dora's mission is to encourage the appreciation and enrichment of music, art, drama, and dance in our local communities of Mount Dora, Eustis, Tavares and Umatilla. Their fundraising efforts, during the past 39 years, support the development and continuing education of local high school students through scholarships in the arts. In each of the past three years (i.e., 2014, 2015, and 2016), the Women's Committee of the Fine Arts awarded sixteen \$1,000 scholarships to students in the performing and visual arts (8 scholarships each). The Christmas Tour of Homes is our primary fundraising event to support these.

With the passing of Lee Dodge, the family has started a yearly scholarship for the performing arts. Artisans on fifth invites Florida artists and craftspeople to apply to be a

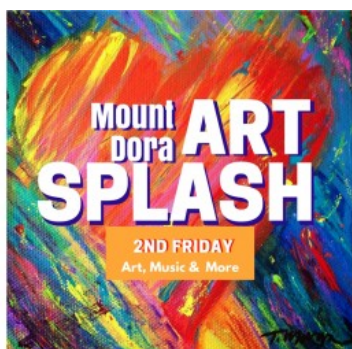
Consignor. After being juried-in, an artist would submit several pieces of artwork to be displayed on a consignment basis. The Consignors are not required to work in the shop, and they receive 60% of each sale. There is a \$120 (\$20/month) fee for a 6-month contract.
