## ANNE BULMER AND LAURA HOWELL

During May, the artwork of Anne Bulmer and Laura Howell will be featured at Artisans on fifth. Anne does intricate basket maker and Laura is a photographer.

**Anne Bulmer** has been a basket maker since 2008. She has always been intrigued by baskets, and while strolling through a street festival in Leesburg, FL one day, she passed a woman who was not only selling her baskets, but demonstrating her craft and willing to talk, in depth, about it. That was it - arrangements were made for lessons and she was off and weaving and have never looked back.

Anne makes "Nantucket" and "Shaker" baskets using hardwoods and cane. They are intricately woven by hand. To find out more about how she makes her baskets, visit <u>her page</u> on our website.

No basket made of interwoven materials such as cane, twigs, rushes, thin strips of wood, or other flexible material can be machine-made. When you find a basket that interests you, look at it carefully and remember someone, somewhere used their hands to make these truly handmade items. Use your baskets, enjoy your baskets, don't abuse your baskets and they will never wear out.







**Laura Howell** is an award-winning photographer. Laura is a fine art photographer who began pursuing her interest in photography in 2002. ## 4-HOUR PARKING COMING TO DOWNTOWN MT. DORA



The City has informed us of the following:

On March 28, 2018 the City will begin installing these signs in the downtown core from 5th Ave to 3rd Avenue and Donnelly to Alexander.

The four-hour time limit is only for on-street parking (all parking lots and the parking garage are free parking at all times). The four-hour time limit will be active 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (all week). Again, all parking lots and the parking garage are not included and offer free parking.

The downtown four (4) hour parking time-limit includes the following streets:

- \* 3rd Avenue, from Baker Street to Alexander Street
- \* 4th Avenue, from Baker Street to Alexander Street
- \* 5th Avenue, from Baker Street to Alexander Street
- \* Alexander Street, from 3rd Avenue to 5th Avenue
- \* Donnelly Street from Railroad Tracks to 5th Avenue

In addition, the existing 15-minute parking time limit spaces will remain (some of these locations will be adjusted).

The Free All-Day Parking lots will remain open to the public and the businesses. These lots are located at Baker Street and 5th Avenue, Tremain Street and Alexander Street. There is a parking garage at Donnelly and Charles that is free and open all day/night. Parking around City Hall and Donnelly Park will remain open to the public for all-day use.



The locations are safe and Mount Dora Police patrol often to make sure your vehicles are secure in those areas. We want our businesses to thrive in the downtown area by giving visitors a chance to enjoy the restaurants and shops. Again, we offer many locations within walking distance that have free all-day parking!


## **LAURA WINS AGAIN**
