

Each piece incorporates a variety of individual glass elements in addition to glass powders and small pieces of glass called 'frit'. Every piece is fired individually before adding to the final piece. They then are fused in a glass kiln anywhere from 12 hours up to a couple days for some of her thicker pieces.
